Departure by Gran Turismo coach. Guided tour of the archaeological site recognized as World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1998

The city was founded by Greek colonists under the name of Poseidonia and became the most popular location in Magna Graecia.

During your visit you can admire its three incredible Doric temples dating back to the 6th century BC: the Temple of Neptune, the Temple of Ceres and the basilica, similar to the Parthenon in Athens, the amphitheatre, the forum and the markets.

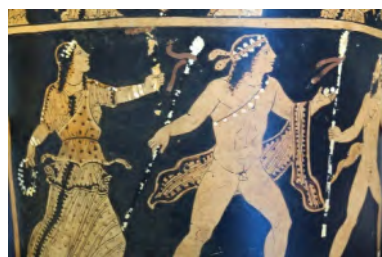
You will then visit the fascinating National Archaeological Museum where some of the most beautiful works of art from Magna Graecia from the 7th century BC are exhibited. including the frescoes of the Tomb of the Diver and the red-figure crater of Astreas.

At the end of the visit, free time for shopping. Return to the hotel.

Meeting with the tour escort in the lobby of your hotel. Departure by Gran Turismo coach. Arrival in Pompeii. Guided tour of the ancient city buried by the volcanic eruption in 79 AD.

Its monuments, its houses, its temples have been extraordinarily preserved.

During your visit you will have the opportunity to learn about and fully immerse yourself in the history and tragedy of this exciting city from the Roman era.

At the end of the visit, free time for shopping. Return to the hotel. (duration approximately 6 hours)

Amalfi



Meeting with the tour escort in the lobby of your hotel.
Departure by Gran Turismo coach for Salerno. Arrival and boarding the ferry that will take you to Amalfi.

After leaving the port of Salerno, you will reach Amalfi crossing the suggestive coast.

From the sea you can admire the typical Mediterranean vegetation with its famous lemon trees, the villas and all the picturesque villages such as Vietri sul Mare, Cetara, Erchie, Maiori, Minori and Atrani. These places were



praised by Giovanni Boccaccio in his "Decameron" and are known throughout the world. In 1997 UNESCO proclaimed the Amalfi Coast as a "world heritage site".



In Amalfi, an ancient Maritime Republic, you can walk through its alleys full of artisan shops and you can visit the historic center of the city and the Sicilian Arab-style cathedral with its splendid mosaics.

At the end of the visit, free time for shopping. Return to the hotel.
